

GENERAL HOUSE RULES

- No one under the age of 21 is permitted in the bingo hall
- 2. Please place cell phones or other devices in silent mode
- Guests may have conversations at a respectable volume level. Concerns should be brought to the attention of management to decide acceptable levels. Guests should not confront others.
- A bingo is only considered valid on the last number called; the ball on the monitor is not valid until called.
- 5. It is the player's responsibility to call bingo loud enough for the caller to stop the game prior to the letter of the next ball being called. Attendants are allowed to assist the caller to stop the game when possible.
- A bingo is only considered valid on the last number called; the ball on the monitor is not valid until called.
- 7. As a service to our guests, bingo attendants may tend to a player's cards for a period of no longer than 1 game. The attendant may claim bingo in the guest's absence and must be verified by a separate attendant.
- 8. Once the caller starts to call the letter of the next number, no previous bingos will be honored, and the game will continue.
- Once the caller has officially closed the game no more bingos will be honored. As, long as the player claims bingo prior to the game being announced as "closed" the bingo will be honored.
- Electronic devices, Flashboards, and TV monitors are for the guest's convenience only and any malfunctions voids pays and plays.
- 11. A dauber must be used to mark paper bingo cards.
- 12. Smoking of any kind, including vapes, are not permitted in the bingo hall.
- 13. There are no cash refunds; in the event of a session cancelation, guest's admission receipt is redeemable within two (2) weeks.

- 14. There is no reserving or saving of seats for other players not present on casino property. Reservations for Fix Base units or Tables for parties of 6 or more may be made with management prior to session sales.
- 15. Casino Del Sol Resort is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 16. No splitting or sharing of packs is permitted
- 17. In the event there are multiple winners in a game, the published payout will be divided accordingly amongst the winners.
- Must be bought into the early bird and/or late bird sessions in, order to play the jackpot specials.
- Taxable Jackpots, Sunburst, Fireball, and MPBingo require a signed or player's card coded admission receipt to validate their purchase.
- 20. All paper must be purchased from the cashiers and used the day of purchase. No paper may be used or reused once the game has been officially closed.
- 21. Winnings of \$1,200 or more are subject to IRS and Title 31 regulations. Guests must provide two (2) forms of legal identification when claiming a payout; Non-U.S. Citizens are also subject to U.S. Tax Regulations.
- 22. Management reserves the right to refuse service to any person; to change modify or cancel any promotions, rules and/or games at any time with prior notification to the Tribal Gaming Office.
- 23. In the event a dispute is not covered by these rules, management will make all final decisions.
- 24. Disputes involving the casino's refusal to pay alleged winnings not covered by these rules may be subject to the Pascua Yaqui Tribal Gaming Ordinance's Section 580 Patron Dispute Hearings (8 PYTC § 2-1-570).
