# GOLF TIP: PLAYING #4

The tee shot at Sewailo's 4th hole is a fun challenge. This hole is a dogleg left with a stream running up the left side. Select the best line off the tee and the correct club to land in the fairway. Your

drive needs to fit in between the left and right fairway bunker. The safe play off the tee is to drive more to the right side and land short of the right fairway bunker. There is more risk involved the farther left you play your drive. The farther left you go, you bring in a couple of fairway bunkers and the stream into play. Once you have successfully executed the tee shot, you will be set up to score well on this hole. Be sure to select enough club to clear the lake in front of the green.
