DID YOU KNOW: TY BUTLER

Sewailo Golf Club is a collaboration between course designers Ty Butler and Notah Begay III. Butler helped to transform completely flat desert terrain into a golf course with rolling terrain. Sewailo meaning “land where the flowers grow” in the Yaqui language, includes abundant landscaping interwoven with the desert environment and finishing holes with flowering plants. The course has a lush environment and desert terrain to create an “oasis” effect. Ty has spent over 25 years designing, renovating and constructing nationally ranked golf



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courses around the world. Many of Butler's course designs are ranked highly in their states by Golf Digest, Golf Magazine, and Golf Week.

DID YOU KNOW: SEWAILO WATER FEATURES

Sewailo has water features on 10 of the 18 holes. These are not just your standard irrigation ponds. They are extensively designed creeks, ponds, lakes, and waterfalls. The streams at Sewailo are over 1.75 miles in length. There are 12 acres of lakes



plus small aesthetic ponds. The streams are designed to be as natural looking as possible.

HOLE IN ONE

On Saturday, February 1st, John Paul Malham aced

#15 using a 6 iron from 167 yards.

On Monday, February 17th, Jamie Heath aced #3 using a pitching wedge from 120 yards.

GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH: HITTING INTO THE WIND AND DOWNWIND

When hitting into the wind, swing easier. A smooth swing will help you strike the ball more solidly. The harder you swing the more spin you will

put on the ball, which is the opposite of what you want to do. To get less spin and lower ball flight, grip down on the club. Use less loft and take at least one extra club. Play the ball back in your stance just to the right of center. This will encourage a lower ball flight. When you are

hitting downwind, distance control on iron shots is more challenging. Land the ball in the front or short of the green allowing it to release on the to the hole. Take one less club than normal or swing the club you would normally hit very easy. Widen your stance for better balance in the wind.
